Opening Prayer: Fr. Weldon opened the meeting with a prayer at approximately 7:40 P.M.

1. **Approval of minutes:** Minutes for April 2017 were approved as written.

2. **Old Business:**

1. **Kitchen**

- Fr. Jim reported that service was performed on the stove that seems to have corrected the issues with the oven and burners.
- Dishwasher hot water is being addressed by parishioner Bob Malicoat to clean pre-heater of calcium buildup. Work in process.

2. **Neighborhood Groups Update:** Letter sent to leaders. Time to begin first meetings. Suggestion made that an item for discussion and future participation could be the Convocation of Catholic Leaders on The Joy of the Gospel in America from Pope Francis's Apostolic Exhortation, The Joy of the Gospel. See Advance June 16, 2017.

3. Items for discussion include:

- As a diocese what are we doing well?
- What could we have done or be doing better?
- What should be our pastoral priorities for the next five years?

4. **Formed:** A discussion about parish participation in the on line program. Just over 100 participate from our parish. Fr. Jim plans to renew the parish subscription.

5. **Welcoming Committee.** Headed by Molly Weiss is very active. Provides church tours to new parishioners

6. **Parish Survey Action Items.** Neighborhood Groups will improve parishioner faith participation. College outreach will be improved by participating in the Stay Connected program sponsored by the Diocesan Office of Faith Formation. David Babich will get application forms from OFF and start developing a roster of college students from our parish for submission to Stay Connected..

3. **New Business:**

1. **Gym.** Arnold Kline construction is working on refreshing the gym by painting ceiling and deep cleaning and painting restrooms.
2. **School.** A second set of Kindergarten classes started last school year. Fr. Jim indicated that in addition to two Kindergarten classes there will be two 1st grade classes this fall. That class has 29 students so will be a class of 15 and 14 in the fall. A discussion followed about the financial viability of that plan. Fr. Jim said the finance committee will report on the finances of the parish following the close of the fiscal year June 30 at which time the financial implications should become clearer.

4. **Closing Prayer:** Fr. Weldon closed the meeting with a prayer.

5. **ADJOURNMENT:** Meeting adjourned at 8:40 PM. Next meeting is August 24 at 7:30 PM.
