




I would like to welcome your child to my class! I am looking forward to getting to know you and your child. I am sure we are going to have a year full of learning, fun and adventures.



- \* Sight Words (will be provided)


Encourage and support your child when he or she is doing their school work. Spend time with your child reading a book, writing or playing a game just for fun every night.



# Mass

Grades K-4 will attend Mass every Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. Fridays are always all - school Mass.

Mass is to begin at 8:00 A.M. if you arrive late (tardy), you can meet the class at church.

The second grade class is expected to participate in the Mass (Liturgy). They are expected to sing, bow, genuflect, kneel, and make the Sign of the Cross when necessary. They need to make the Sign of the Cross with their right hand and genuflect down on their right knee. Please model and practice this with your child.

# Agenda Book

Second Grade students will have an agenda this year, and will be expected to write their homework and assignments in it daily. I will periodically be checking to make sure they are using it correctly, and also occasionally may write a note to parents if there is a change in routine.

**\*\*\*Students will be required to have their agenda signed/initialed every night. \*\*\***

## Accelerated Reader

Students will have library every week to check out a library book. Students will have some free time throughout the week to take their test. I would tentatively like students to take an AR test at least once a week, but if they do not get to it, the following week will work as well. I encourage students to be reading at least 20 minutes a night with a parent or sibling.

\*\*\*Students will be required to complete 5 passing AR test each quarter.\*\*\*

## Stewardship

As part of our stewardship promise, students will be required to complete a total of 2 stewardship hours in second grade. We ask that each student complete at least 30 minutes per quarter. At the end of each quarter, I will check their stewardship sheets to make sure their hours have been completed and signed off. This sheet can be found on page 25 of their agenda book.

## Study Skills

To help your student be successful in Second Grade, you should plan on reviewing learning skills at home for at least 20 minutes each night. This includes but is not limited to their prayers, sight words, handwriting and numbers.

## Dress Code

Please follow the Parent/Student handbook. Reminder notes will be sent home for any violations.

## Attendance

If contacted, work can be prepared and outside the front office for pick by the end of the day. I can also send work home with older siblings. Please send them to pick up at the end of the day.

## Classroom Water Bottles

Your child may bring a water bottle to keep on their desk if they would like. However, it must be a spill proof (push-pull) lid. Water's with large openings or screw top waters will not be allowed to be at their desk.

## Birthdays

Your child may celebrate his or her birthday at school on their birthday. We will celebrate birthdays during snack time. Please keep it simple. Treats must be healthy so please get creative! Cupcakes and cake will not be allowed!

## Food Allergies

Please let me know as soon as possible if your child has a food allergy. Several of our science lessons involve food.

# Classroom Rules
